

Power Supply Upgrade Program

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Transport for NSW is upgrading electrical infrastructure. This upgrade is part of the Power Supply Upgrade Program, which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air-conditioned trains.

Weekend and weekday work

We will be working on The Crescent, Auburn, between Normanby Road and South Parade, from **7am to 6pm on Saturday 3 November.** Work will involve the removal of a street light pole that is in close proximity to the rail power lines.

We will also be installing two new street light poles by the end of November.

These works relate to power supply services to the light poles and within the rail corridor only and will not affect residential services.

Traffic changes in your area

To undertake the work described above and to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists and workers, there will be temporary changes to traffic conditions on The Crescent. Please see below for more information on temporary changes in your area.

Through traffic will be maintained at all times, although short delays may be experienced. Traffic control will be in place to safety direct traffic and pedestrians. Please follow directions and proceed carefully. **Access to local properties will be maintained.**

What you may notice

Partial lane closure - The Crescent

On **Saturday 3 November** there will be temporary lane closures on The Crescent, between Normanby Road and South Parade between 7am and 6pm.

Temporary removal of parking spaces

During the removal and installation of the power poles, five on-street parking spaces will be temporarily required to allow the partial lane closure to be in place and provide access for a crane truck to remove and install the street lights.

Construction equipment

Equipment to be used includes a crane truck, a cherry picker, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles and various hand and power tools.
