Transport for NSW is upgrading electrical infrastructure. This upgrade is part of the Power Supply Upgrade Program, which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air conditioned trains.

### Upcoming activities

In November, we will commence the removal of redundant overhead structures and footings in the rail corridor adjacent to Rawson Street, Auburn. See the map overleaf for the work area.

### Weekend work

We will be working in the rail corridor at Auburn **between 6am and 6pm on Saturday 3 November**.

These construction activities relate to **power supply services within the rail corridor only and will not affect residential services**.

Work to be carried out includes the cutting and removal of two redundant steel overhead structures and removal of concrete footings.

There will be no impact to passenger services at Auburn however there are track work on the Olympic Line this weekend which may affect passenger services. ### What you may notice

#### Construction equipment

Equipment to be used includes excavators, vehicles including a cherry picker and trailer, and various hand and power tools.

This work may be noisy, but we will also take every possible step to reduce noise. This will include switching off machinery when not in use and monitoring noise.
