## Rockdale Station improvement works

From Tuesday 4 December to Wednesday 12 December

### What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking staged platform construction work at Rockdale Station from Tuesday 4 December to Wednesday 12 December.

To improve network safety and reduce the need for ongoing maintenance, we're working on rebuilding Platforms 2 and 3 over the next two years.

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

### How this affects you

#### Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night over the weekend. We apologise for the inconvenience this may cause.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 4am Saturday 8 December to 6am Monday 10 December.**
- Finishing works may take place following this period for minor construction works.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Due to travel restrictions on large vehicles, some deliveries may occur at night.

#### Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will access the rail corridor via Alexandra Parade, Geeves Avenue and Railway Street.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking and station car parks may be limited near the worksite.
- These works will require the use of several items of heavy plant. To ensure the heavy plant is available for use when required, a site compound will be established in the commuter carpark on Railway Street in between Oakura Street and Gloucester Street.
- **The commuter carpark on Railway Street will be closed from Tuesday 4 December to Wednesday 12 December.** Alternate car parking can be found along Alexandra Parade, Geeves Avenue and Railway Street.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist vehicle movements in and out of the rail corridor.
