

Transport Access Program Wye Station Upgrade



The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Wye Station

Key features include:

- three new lifts to provide access to the pedestrian footbridge and station platforms
- upgrades to the existing pedestrian pathways to improve access from the Gorokan Road commuter car park and the Wye Road Council car park
- a new kiss-and-ride space on Gorokan Road
- an additional accessible parking space in the Gorokan Road commuter car park
- formalising the crossing on Wye Road
- improvements to CCTV, wayfinding and lighting to increase safety and security
- a new family accessible toilet, and improved waiting room accessibility
- new stairs to replace the current ramp.

- a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability and limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage
- a modern interchange that supports an integrated network and offers customers seamless transfers between transport modes


Between **5pm and 7pm** on **Thursday 8 November**, representatives from the Transport for NSW project team will be located at **Wyee Station**.

Subject to planning approval, construction is expected to commence in early 2019 and be completed in 2020.

Keeping you informed

Station access

Transport for NSW will notify the community ahead of time about any potential changes to the operation of the station precinct.

To allow for access upgrades there will be some temporary impacts to vehicles and pedestrians with closures and diversions along Wyee Road and Gorokan Road.

There is also potential for a temporary reduction in parking availability during construction at the Gorokan Road commuter car park.

Further notification and signage highlighting these changes will be issued when plans for these works are finalised.

Track work weekends as scheduled by Sydney Trains will be used by the project team to undertake works safely when trains are not running and to minimise disruptions to train services at Wyee Station.

Power Supply Upgrades

To operate the 3 new lifts, a power supply upgrade is required in the Wyee Station area. This will be undertaken by Ausgrid, and any impact to local residents as a result of these upgrades will be communicated ahead of time by Transport for NSW and Ausgrid.
