

# **Transport Access Program**

**Merrylands Commuter Car Park** 

## **COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION**

**FEBRUARY 2018** 

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure. Transport for NSW in conjunction with delivery partner AW Edwards is upgrading Merrylands Commuter Car Park to provide additional commuter parking.

## Major construction and closure of the commuter car park commenced Monday, 22 January2018. Construction will occur for approximately 10 months. The project includes:

- additional levels to provide approximately 65 additional spaces including up to 6 new accessible parking spaces within the existing commuter car park adjacent to Merrylands Station and near the bus interchange, improving interchangeability between transport modes
- new lift and stairs at the existing commuter car park to improve accessibility to the station and the bus interchange
- approximately 20 at-grade 90-degree angle parking spaces along Railway Terrace, approximately 300 metres north-east of Merrylands Station
- installation of CCTV security cameras at the existing commuter car park to improve security.

## Temporary car park closure

Transport for NSW apologises for any inconvenience caused as a result of the Merrylands Commuter Car Park being **closed for approximately 10 months** while the additional levels are constructed. These additional levels will provide extra parking capacity for commuters to and from Merrylands Station and the bus interchange, as demand grows.

To assist mobility impaired users with this change, we have converted 5 parking spaces on the eastern side of the station on Railway Terrace to 3 accessible parking spaces for the duration of construction. Signage has been installed to notify car park users of these changes.

Please consider alternative public transport options or parking at nearby stations during this period.

We appreciate your cooperation during these important works.

## Start of main construction works

Main construction works commenced on Monday, 22 January 2018. Works to be undertaken over the coming months will include:

- commencement of construction of foundations for the additional levels being constructed within the existing commuter car park
- commencement of civil works, in ground works and the installation of additional services
- commencement of construction of lift and stairs
- commencement of construction of concrete base slab for the car park structure.

## **Construction plant and equipment**

Plant and equipment which may be used over the coming months includes:

- pile rigs
- excavators
- bobcats
- telehandler
- concrete pump
- agitators
- construction and delivery vehicles
- cranes
- hand and power tools, including circular saws, drills and screw guns.

### **Standard construction hours**

Work will occur during standard construction hours which are **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. Additional notification of any works outside of these hours will be provided to the community prior to those works commencing.

Every effort will be made to minimise the noise impact on nearby residents and businesses. We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience during this important work. We will issue regular community notifications throughout the duration of the project to keep the community informed about the progress of works.
