The Transport Access Program is a Transport for NSW initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.



Landscaping and canopies around lift landing on Wentworth Avenue and Portico Parade

Toongabbie Station Upgrade is nearing completion, with the site now transformed into a modernised and accessible station. The anti-throw screens have been installed, and civil and landscaping works on both Portico and Wentworth Avenues have been completed around the lift landings.

This month, a mural created by students at local school The Hills Sports High and local Artist Danielle RG will be installed within the Portico Parade bus shelter, a new and exciting edition to the Toongabbie Station upgrade to promote community pride and acknowledge the history of the land.

Additional works to take place on the station upgrade this month will include:

- roofing replacement
- removal of the hoarding around lifts
- lift power cables
- installation of indicator boards

Out of hours works

From 2am Saturday 21 April to 2am Monday 23 April 2018

This weekend work has been planned during a scheduled Sydney Trains shutdown to provide safe access for workers and minimise disruption to rail users. **Toongabbie station footbridge will remain OPEN to pedestrians.**

Buses will replace trains from the bus stop located on Wentworth Avenue (before Barangaroo Road).

Traffic controllers will be present to assist pedestrians, and to direct commuters to train replacement buses.

Please follow directional signage around the station to the replacement buses. For enquiries regarding rail services during the weekend works, please contact the Transport Infoline on 131 500.

From 2am Monday 23 April to 6am Tuesday 24 April 2018

Night work will continue on Monday and Tuesday mornings, with **no impacts to train services or the footbridge during these hours.** This work may be noisy at times, every effort will be made to minimise impact on the community.

Standard construction hours

Construction works for the Toongabbie Station Upgrade will be undertaken throughout the month during standard working hours, which are

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and
- 8am to 1pm Saturday.

Notification of any works occurring outside of these standard hours will be given prior to works commencing.
