Springwood to Lithgow Rail Corridor Modifications

MAY 2019 COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION – WOODFORD STATION

The NSW Government is delivering a New Intercity Fleet to replace the trains carrying customers from Sydney to the Central Coast, Newcastle, the Blue Mountains and the South Coast.

The new state-of-the-art trains will replace the ageing V-Sets to provide customers with a more comfortable and reliable journey. The trains will feature wider, more spacious seats with arm rests, charging facilities for mobile devices, two by two seating for extra room and comfort, dedicated spaces for luggage, prams, bicycles and wheelchairs, improved accessibility including accessible toilets, tray tables with cup holders, improved customer information through digital information screens and announcements, CCTV and help points, and modern air conditioning.

Project overview

Modifications are needed along the rail corridor from west of Springwood Station to Lithgow Station, including minor modifications to the Ten Tunnels Deviation (between Newnes Junction Station and Zig Zag Station), to allow the new trains to service customers all the way to Lithgow.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday. Work during standard construction hours on Friday 24 May, Saturday 25 May and Monday 27 May includes set up, use and demobilisation of a temporary site compound and track slewing. Some work will be required outside these hours.

To minimise impacts to the local community, most work will be completed during scheduled trackwork weekends/shutdown periods when alternative travel arrangements, such as buses, are in place.

Out of hours weekend work – Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 May 2019

We will be working from **5am Saturday 25 May to 10pm Sunday 26 May 2019** at Woodford Station. Work will include the use of a temporary site compound and activities associated with track slewing.

All work will be carried out within the rail corridor. Construction vehicle access to the site area will be via the Great Western Highway. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

To ensure the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains track work period. Train services will be affected. Please contact Transport Info on 131 500 or visit transportnsw.info for more information about replacement bus services.

What you may notice

Equipment to be used includes excavators, dump trucks, saw, tamper, regulator, construction vehicles, welding equipment, grinder, hand tools, scissor lift and generators. This work may be noisy at times however we will take every possible step to reduce noise.


Some areas of the platform, including toilets, will not be accessible while work is being completed.
