Beecroft Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

June 2019

Beecroft Station is being upgraded as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) which aims to provide a better experience for customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated public transport infrastructure. Subject to further consultation with key stakeholders, Beecroft Station upgrade scope would include:

- two new lifts
- new and upgraded access paths throughout the station precinct
- upgrade to station interchange facilities
- improvements to CCTV, wayfinding signage and lighting.

Project update

Following the granting of Planning Approval in February 2019, detailed design work is now underway on the Beecroft Station Upgrade. In order to progress the design, a suite of on-site investigative works are required to be undertaken. These site investigation works are currently expected to take no more than three months to complete.

Weekend Works: 8-9 June and 13-14 July (7am to 5pm each day)

During the scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekends of 8-9 June 2019 and 13-14 July 2019, site investigation activities will occur from 7am to 5pm each day. These works will include geotechnical investigations, underground services investigation, surveying and station building condition inspections. These investigations will occur within the rail corridor including on the station platforms, within the station access ramps and the underpass, and within the adjacent car parking areas and roads. Work has been planned during the scheduled trackwork weekends when no trains will be running, to improve the safety of workers and minimise impact on the community.

Equipment will include a small geotechnical drilling rig, a vacuum truck for services investigations, surveying equipment and hand tools. Some of this work may be noisy at times. Noise monitoring will be in place during this time and actions will be taken to minimise noise where possible.

In preparation for the site investigations as indicated above, a small temporary site compound will be set up in the two days prior to each weekend with access off Sutherland Road, and location as indicated on the plan overleaf. On completion of each weekend's work, the site compound will be decommissioned the following week.

There will be some temporary parking loss at some of the investigation sites. Signage will be in place to advise pedestrians and car park users.

Weekday site investigations throughout June and July 2019

Site investigations will continue from Tuesday 11 June until end of July 2019 during normal working hours of Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm, weather permitting. These works will include road pavement and geotechnical investigations, underground services investigation, and surveying. Location of investigations external to the station are indicated in the above plan.
