


Transport Access Program Birrong Station Upgrade Have your say



The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Birrong Station

Have your say on the proposed improvements to Birrong Station. Key features include:

- a new pedestrian footbridge on Rodd Street to provide access over the rail corridor
- a new lift connecting the new pedestrian footbridge with the station platform
- two accessible parking spaces
- improved kiss and ride area
- landscaping at station entrances
- improved amenities such as new male and female ambulant toilet, an upgraded family accessible toilet, CCTV, lighting and wayfinding.


Transport Access Program
