Mortdale Maintenance Centre is being upgraded to maintain our expanding train fleets and prepare our network for the future needs of a growing Sydney. Novo Rail is delivering the work on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Upcoming work in June

During June a temporary site office will be erected inside the south-west access gate. Work activities will include the delivery and placement of the site offices, connecting services to these offices and traffic management positioned at the access gate on the south-west end of Hurstville Road, for the duration of the project. This work will occur during standard construction hours from **7am to 6pm on Monday 24 June to Thursday 27 June.**

Out-of-hours work

In addition to this work we also plan to relocate existing fire hydrants and install hoardings inside the facility, working from **6am to 6pm on Saturday 29 June and Sunday 30 June.** To ensure the safety of our staff, this work is being carried out while overhead power is turned off within the shed area. Electrical supply to the surrounding area will not be affected.

Every effort will be made to reduce the impact of this work through noise mitigation, which includes switching off equipment when it is not being used, locating equipment as far away from properties as possible, and monitoring our work activities to make sure noise and vibration levels are being managed effectively.

What you may notice

Equipment to be used includes large transport and construction vehicles, mobile cranes, a scissor lift, jack hammers, concrete mixers, generators, concrete saws, welders, angle grinders and various small hand and powered tools.

Site access for workers and deliveries will be from the access gate on the south-west end of Hurstville Road. Roadside parking may be impacted by work crews parking near the site, and temporary closure of some roadside parking opposite the access gate on **Tuesday 25 June** to allow for site deliveries by larger vehicles.

Deliveries will take place intermittently from **7am to 6pm on Monday to Friday** and from **6am to 6pm on Saturday 29 June and Sunday 30 June.** Traffic management may be required for some site deliveries, which may occasionally affect traffic congestion.
