FNAP eligibility criteria fact sheet

What happens once you've submitted an application?

When we receive your completed form, we assess your application against our eligibility criteria.

Sometimes, after our initial review, we will investigate further, such as by monitoring noise in the area.

We will write to you within 20 business days to tell you what will happen next.

Which properties are eligible for the program?

To be eligible for FNAP building treatment, your dwelling must:

- be classified as an 'occupied residence' or noise sensitive land use
- not be part of a building more than 3 levels above ground
- not be part of a development that was approved after 1 January 2009.

Noise levels at the dwelling must be above 70 decibels during the day (L_{Aeq}(15hour) 7am to 10pm) or 65 decibels at night (L_{Aeq}(9hour) 10pm to 7am).

How much does treatment cost and who pays?

We look for treatment options that are cost-effective, fair and practical. Treatments might cost up to \$30,000 for each dwelling.

If you have owned your property for less than 7 years, we will offer to share costs with you as follows:

Ownership time (at offer)	Owner contribution
0–2 years	85%
2–3 years	70%
3–4 years	55%
4–5 years	35%
5–6 years	20%
6–7 years	10%
7+ years	0%

Which properties receive treatment first?

We prioritise properties based on how serious the noise is and how often it occurs at night. We look at factors like the level and type of noise each property is exposed to.

We also consider the date we received a completed FNAP application form.
