Project update

The Glenbrook Station Upgrade is progressing well, with the construction of four piles for the new walkway ramp and the completion of the lift pit.

In May, upgrade work will continue and includes:

- sawcutting of platforms 1 and 2
- installation of new transformer
- installation of new pedestrian walkway ramp
- upgrade of station toilets.

Station access will also be temporarily altered to allow for construction of new stairs. The station will remain accessible during this time.

Weekend Work – from 2am Saturday 25 May to 2am Monday 27 May

From **2am Saturday 25 May to 2am Monday 27 May 2019** preparation, delivery and installation of lift shafts and lift landings will take place at Glenbrook Station.

To ensure the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. No train services will be operating this weekend. Please contact Transport Info on **131 500** or visit **transportnsw.info** for more information about replacement bus services.

Some of these works may be noisy at times and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Traffic update

During standard working hours in May, traffic and pedestrian control will be set up at the intersection of Burfitt Parade and Ross Street. All vehicular traffic turning from Ross Street onto Burfitt Parade will be operational in both directions. Pedestrian access to the station will be maintained.

On Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 May traffic control will continue between Ross Street and Burfitt Parade, and will also be operational along Station Street. Street access will remain but will be under the direction of traffic control.

This traffic control is required for the safety of vehicles, pedestrians and workers during the operation of pumps, generators and use of delivery trucks.

Equipment to be used

Equipment to be used will be construction vehicles, including concrete and delivery trucks, a crane, power and hand tools.

Standard working hours

Standard work hours are between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

We will continue to inform the community ahead of any works outside of standard work hours.
