Project update

During July, NAIDOC celebrations were held at Glenbrook Station, with morning and afternoon tea shared which included jams and preserves made from native Australian ingredients such as Quandong fruit and Lily Pilli with damper.

Work completed in July includes:

- continued progress on the Burfitt Parade station entry walkway and new stairs
- start of installation of the family accessible toilet and ambulant toilet
- hoarding on the platform has been extended in preparation of the lift car delivery and start of building the brick façade around the lift shaft

Work planned for August

During August, work will include:

- completion and opening of new stairs
- continued progress on the ambulant and family accessible toilets
- construction of the brick façade around the lift shaft
- installation of electrical and communication systems
- ongoing installation and testing of a new station transformer
- ongoing work on stormwater and drainage around the city end of the platform
- continued progress on the station entry walkway construction
- installation of external walls and handrails at the lift entrance

New stairs to access the station will be opened to public during August. Work will continue to take place on the new station entry walkway. Signage will be installed to guide the community during the work. The station will remain open during this time.
