Foreword



Message from the Hon. Andrew Constance, MP

The NSW Government is investing in the largest transport infrastructure program our country has seen with \$55.6 billion allocated across the next four years to deliver on the commitments made to ease congestion, connect communities and improve journeys.

At the heart of this investment is a focus on our customers - the people of NSW. It's all about delivering on our commitments and moving people safely and more efficiently, in a highly integrated transport system that supports economic growth and connected communities - from the city to the bush.

Our investment will provide our growing population with the options they need to move around greater Sydney and across the vast expanses of our State - from road, rail, bus to ferries.

\$480 million has been allocated to upgrade sections of Mamre and Mulgoa roads to support the fastest growing region in NSW -Western Sydney. This investment, like the \$450 million allocated to ease congestion at key pinch points demonstrates the commitment to local and major motorway road projects across Greater Sydney. The NSW Government is transforming how our customers use our roads to improve connections, ease congestion and ensure faster, safer and more reliable journeys.

In response to the rapid increase in patronage and trips on the Sydney Train heavy rail network we are investing over \$4.3 billion into the More Trains, More Services program to transform the rail network and provide customers with more reliable, high capacity turn up and go services.

We are keeping our promises to our customers, by fully funding Sydney Metro West, placing us in a stronger position than ever to expedite construction on this pivotal project. The completion of this will see a doubling of the existing capacity on the T1 Western Line and travel times reduced between Greater Paramatta and the Sydney CBD to around twenty minutes. This project alone will create 10,000 direct and 70,000 indirect jobs.

This scale of investment in road and rail infrastructure, demands a pipeline of skilled and capable people to deliver these projects. The jobs created will support local communities and ensure there are social and economic benefits to the investments we make across NSW.

We've always had a simple, but very important goal - to make NSW an even better place to live, work and do business. All the projects backed by the NSW Government's investment in infrastructure will enable us to reach that goal and achieve a connected transport system that improves our customers' journeys and the communities they live in for generations to come.

Message from the Hon. Paul Toole, MP

The NSW Government is investing record amounts in regional road, rail and freight networks to meet the demands of our communities today and unlock opportunities for future growth.

We are investing where we need it - in rail and road networks to better connect our communities and to make our regional economy stronger; in freight road and rail corridors to allow businesses to get goods to intrastate, interstate and international markets quicker and more efficiently.

We are delivering better connections for communities across the State – from our \$2.5 billion investment into duplication of the Great Western Highway between Katoomba and Lithgow to the sealing of our most remote highways, the Silver City and the Cobb, in the State's far west.

Our investment is delivering safer and faster trips for our customers. The Coffs Harbour bypass will be the final link in the transformation of the Pacific Highway between Hexham and the Queensland border and cut a further 11 minutes from travel times.

On the Princes Highway, we'll build on our \$1.5 billion investment with a further \$960 million of work between Nowra and the Victorian border to make trips safer and more efficient.

With two thirds of fatalities occurring on country roads, we'll maintain our unwavering commitment to road safety for the people of NSW. Safety treatments like audio tactile line marking, flexible safety barriers and wide centerlines will help to reduce run-off-road and head-on crashes as part of the Road Safety Plan 2021.

We are providing more effective and efficient transport opportunities within regional and rural NSW.


