

New 10 km/h ‘SHARED ZONE’: McCubbens Lane, Sutherland

Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link | May 2019



From 15 May 2019, McCubbens Lane, Sutherland, will become a ‘shared zone’ for pedestrians, motorists and cyclists.

The shared zone will be in effect along the full length of McCubbens Lane, between Old Princes Highway and Eton Street, and a new 10 km/h speed will be in force.

McCubbens Lane will remain a one-way street for motorists travelling from west to east, from Old Princes Highway to Eton Street.

The changes are part of the Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link, a pedestrian and bicycle path that will help make walking and bike riding a more convenient, safer and enjoyable transport option.

New street signs will be put in place along McCubbens Lane to inform road users of the changed traffic conditions. The new 10 km/h speed limit will be in force once the signs are in place.
