North Strathfield Station Upgrade

Project update

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Work is progressing well at North Strathfield Station with site establishment nearly complete. Work in the coming months will include:

- piling and excavation work for lift footings
- service relocation and installation
- delivery of materials to site compound.

Upcoming weekend and night work

From **2am Sunday 27 January** to **2am to Monday 28 January** work will be undertaken in addition to standard working hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists. Work during this time will include:

- installation of hoarding within the station precinct
- piling for lift footings on platforms 1/2
- relocation and installation of underground services

Equipment to be used will include excavators, a piling rig, concrete and delivery trucks, a concrete pump, mobile lighting towers, a generator, and power and hand tools.

Pedestrian access to the footbridge will be maintained during this time, and traffic controllers will be available to assist pedestrians past the areas of work. Some of these works may be noisy and we will try to reduce the impacts where possible. This will include:

- only using noisy machinery when there are no other alternatives
- scheduling noisier work during daylight and early evening hours
- turning off machinery when not in use.

These works will be undertaken during a scheduled Sydney Trains shutdown period when no trains will be running. Please visit **transportnsw.info** for up to date information regarding services and replacement buses during this time.

Standard working hours are between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**.
