Petersham Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

27-28 July 2019

Petersham Station will be upgraded as part of the Transport Access Program, which aims to provide a better experience for customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated public transport infrastructure across NSW.

Initial project planning and design development is underway to prepare for the public display of the Review of Environmental Factors, and submission of heritage approval documentation, which is scheduled for later this year. Subject to further consultation, the station upgrade scope may include new lifts, accessible pathways, and new accessible amenities such as a family accessible toilet.

Project Update

Preliminary design work is now underway for Petersham Station Upgrade. To help inform the design, Laing O'Rourke is carrying out a suite of site investigations. These works are expected to take up to three months to complete.

Weekend work and access to the rail corridor via Station Street, Newtown – Saturday 27 and Sunday 28 July

Site investigations will be carried out at Petersham Station in the rail corridor and adjacent streets (Trafalgar and Terminus Streets) during a scheduled Sydney Trains rail shutdown on Saturday 27 July and Sunday 28 July, between 6am and 6pm daily.

Work will include geotechnical investigations, underground services investigation, surveying and station building condition inspections.

To prepare for the work, three trucks will enter the rail corridor via an access gate on Station Street, Newtown at 5:30am Saturday 27 July. They will depart via the same gate by 6pm on Saturday. There will be no road impacts from these movements. For more information, please see the map overleaf.

Work has been planned during scheduled track maintenance weekends, to maintain the safety of workers and minimise impacts on the community.
