Petersham Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

June 2019

Petersham Station will be upgraded as part of the **Transport Access Program**, which aims to provide a better experience for customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated public transport infrastructure across NSW.

Initial project planning and design development is underway to prepare for the public display of the Review of Environmental Factors, and submission of heritage approval documentation, which is scheduled for later this year. Subject to further consultation, the station upgrade scope may include new lifts, accessible pathways, and new accessible amenities such as a family accessible toilet.

Project Update

Preliminary design work is now underway on the Petersham Station Upgrade. In order to progress the design, a suite of on-site investigative work is being undertaken by Laing O'Rourke. These site investigation works are currently expected to take no more than three months to complete.

Weekend Works on 6-7 and 27-28 July 2019

Site investigations are planned to occur during scheduled Sydney Trains maintenance weekends of **6-7 July and 27-28 July 2019, between 6am and 6pm daily. Noisy work will be restricted to 7am to 5pm on Saturdays and 8am to 5pm on Sundays.**

Work will occur predominantly within the rail corridor, on Terminus Street adjacent to Railway Street and Trafalgar Street adjacent to Regent Street. It will include geotechnical investigations, underground services investigation, surveying and station building condition inspections. Equipment will include a vacuum truck, small truck mounted geotechnical drilling rig, surveying equipment and hand tools. Some of this work may be noisy at times. Noise monitoring will be in place during this time and actions will be taken to minimise noise where possible.

In preparation for these weekend works, some plant and equipment may be delivered to the rail corridor at the TfNSW Training Facility off Trafalgar Street.

Work has been planned during the scheduled track maintenance weekends, to improve the safety of workers and minimise impact on the community. **Trains will run as usual at Petersham on 6 and 7 July 2019.** For information regarding **rail replacement buses on 27 and 28 July 2019**, please visit <https://transportnsw.info/trip#/> or phone the Transport for NSW infoline on 131 500.

Weekday site investigation works between 2 July and 26 July 2019

For four weeks **between 2 July and the 26 July**, site investigation activities will be undertaken **Monday to Friday, from 7am to 6pm.**
