



# New Intercity Fleet Eveleigh Facility Project

#### PROJECT COMPLETION

The NSW Government is delivering a New Intercity Fleet to replace the trains carrying customers between Sydney and the Central Coast, Newcastle, the Blue Mountains and the South Coast.

The upgraded Eveleigh maintenance facility can now be used for testing, commissioning, stabling and maintenance of the New Intercity Fleet.





### Finishing our work at Eveleigh

The upgrades and modifications at Eveleigh were completed in **June 2019**. Minor finishing activities will continue in July, however these activities are not expected to be noisy.

#### **Achievements**

Upgrades to the facility will allow the servicing and maintenance of the New Intercity Fleet once it is in service. These upgrades included extensions to tracks and sidings, and supporting infrastructure including signals, walkways, fencing, lighting, underground assets and overhead wiring. The additional repairs carried out have extended the life of the buildings at the facility.

Our team worked closely with Sydney Trains to ensure the safe and efficient passing of trains throughout the facility, coordinating all activities with train movements to avoid disruptions.









During the project, our team took part in local community events, such as helping to plant trees and build the "Elliptical Garden" at Erskineville Public School, where students now enjoy larger play areas with outdoor chalkboards for drawing, a giant chess board and new green spaces and gardens in their school.
