

Stage 1 of the Sutherland to Kirrawee Active Transport Link is expected to be complete in early 2020.

The new paths will connect key destinations such as transport interchanges, schools, residential areas and business precincts, and will help make walking and bike riding a more convenient, safer and enjoyable transport option.

#### Off-setting trees in Sutherland

Over 150 trees will be planted in accordance with Transport for NSW's Vegetation Offset Guide, to replace those which were removed during construction of the new paths. Plantings will occur along the paths, in consultation with Sutherland Shire Council.

## **Continuing work at Sutherland**

Work will continue along President Avenue between Merton Street and Glencoe Street to finish the new pedestrian and bicycle path and to upgrade the car parking spaces outside St Patrick's College.

We are also continuing work along President Avenue between Glencoe Street and Auburn Street. Work along these sections include excavating, concreting and landscaping.

Auburn Street will be closed to traffic from **Thursday 7 November until the morning of Saturday 9 November**. Please see the map overleaf for work locations.

#### **Night work**

Some work is required outside standard work hours to minimise impacts on local traffic and to increase safety for pedestrians and workers. We will have partial closures and detours on President Avenue between Eton Street and Merton Street, and between Glencoe Street and Acacia Road. Our planned night work is detailed below:

- We will require **two night shifts** on **Thursday 7 November** and **Friday 8 November**, between **6pm and 5am** (weather permitting), to build the new pedestrian crossing on Auburn Street.
- We will require four night shifts at the end of November, between 6pm and 5am. This work
  involves tree trimming and removal, and constructing a new pedestrian fence and bike path to
  connect the pathway from Eton Street into President Avenue. We will also be completing line
  marking on Merton Street.

Residents in close proximity to the night work will be provided more information closer to the time.

This work may be noisy at times as it includes truck movements, chainsaws, saw cutting of the road, jack hammering, concreting and asphalting. We will aim to minimise impacts on the community by carrying out noisier work as early as possible, switching off equipment when it is not being used, placing equipment as far away from residential properties as possible, and monitoring our work activities to ensure noise levels are being managed effectively.

## **Changes to parking on President Avenue**

There are ongoing temporary parking changes along President Avenue. Parking spaces between Merton Street and Acacia Road will be temporarily unavailable during construction, to allow for work to be completed safely. Work is being done in stages to minimise the number of parking spaces being unavailable.

## **Traffic changes**

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, with traffic control present when work is in progress.

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and detours may be in place during our work which may affect travel times. Please keep to the speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
