



Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link

Stage 1 Sutherland to Kirrawee

The Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path between Sutherland and Cronulla to help make walking and bike riding a more convenient, safer and enjoyable transport option.

Stage 1 Sutherland to Kirrawee will connect key destinations such as transport interchanges, schools, residential areas and business precincts.

Construction of Stage 1 is underway, and work will be completed progressively between Sutherland and Kirrawee. Stage 1 will be open in sections as each area is completed with bike riders and pedestrians able to use all of Stage 1 by early 2020.

Key features

- Construction of a new pedestrian and bicycle path that provides connections to key destinations
- A 10km/h shared zone at McCubbens Lane
- A separated bike path on Eton Street
- Pedestrian and bike paths on President Avenue (between Eton Street and Oak Road)
- New pedestrian and bike crossings at Merton and Auburn Streets, Acacia Road and Fauna Place
- Utility relocation and installation
- Public domain work including pram ramps, pedestrian and cyclist refuges, signage and landscaping.

More parking available on President Avenue, Sutherland

The work on the southern side of President Avenue (near Merton Street) to convert parallel parking to rear to kerb parking has been completed, providing 14 new parking spaces. These parking spaces have been constructed to help offset the upcoming changes to parking in Eton Street.



Eton Street, Sutherland

Work will start on **Thursday 2 May 2019** on Eton Street, between Flora Street and President Avenue. The work involves constructing a new pedestrian and bicycle crossing, and a separated bicycle path adjacent to Sutherland Public School.

The work on Eton Street will take around eight weeks, weather permitting. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Please see information and the map overleaf for more detail about the work.

Changes to parking on Eton Street

Approximately 24 parking spaces are being permanently removed to allow the separated cycleway (adjacent to Sutherland Public School) and new pedestrian and bike crossing to be built on Eton Street. Removing the parking spaces will preserve five large mature trees adjacent to Sutherland Public School and to allow the new bike path to be separated from the pedestrian path.

Some parking spaces are also being removed to allow sufficient sight lines for all users and providing adequate buffer areas around the new pedestrian and bicycle crossings.

To allow the work on Eton Street to be completed safely, some parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable. Parking changes are listed below:

- **5pm to 5am, Thursday 2 May and Friday 3 May** (temporary parking removal of approximately 27 spaces on the western side of Eton Street to allow work to be completed safely)
- **5am to 5pm, Saturday 4 May and Sunday 5 May** (temporary removal of approximately 40 spaces on the western side of Eton Street and permanent removal of 8 spaces to accommodate the new crossing)
- **7am Monday 6 May** (permanent removal of 16 parking spaces on the eastern side of Eton Street to accommodate the new crossing and bicycle path)



Night and weekend work

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. Some work will be required outside of these hours to minimise impacts on local traffic and for the safety of pedestrians and workers. Work on Eton Street will also occur at night and on weekends to minimise impacts on the community and businesses.

The new pedestrian and bicycle crossing will be constructed from **2 May 2019** to **5 May 2019** on Eton Street during day shifts between **7am** and **6pm** and night shifts between **6pm** and **5am**, weather permitting. If for any reason the works cannot be completed on the above dates, the night works will be completed the following week between **9 May 2019** to **12 May 2019**.

Subject to approval, night work is also scheduled from **6 to 10 May**, **12 to 16 May** and **19 to 23 May 2019** on Eton Street to construct the bicycle path adjacent to Sutherland Public School between **6pm** and **5am**.

This work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise impacts by completing noisier work as early as possible, switching off equipment when it is not being used, placing equipment as far away from properties as possible, and monitoring our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and detours will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to the speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Kiss and ride parking

The kiss and ride parking on Eton Street will be relocated to Flora Street, adjacent to Sutherland Public School. See map on previous page.

Construction equipment

Night work activities will include movement of trucks, removing concrete barriers, saw cutting of the road surface, asphaltting and the use of various hand and power tools. We will also be completing excavation activities, concreting, as well as chain sawing and mulching of trees.
