



# Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link

## Stage 1 Sutherland to Kirrawee – Site Compound

The Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path between Sutherland and Cronulla to help make walking and bike riding a more convenient, safer and enjoyable transport option.

Stage 1 Sutherland to Kirrawee will connect key destinations such as transport interchanges, schools, residential areas and business precincts.

Construction of Stage 1 is underway and work will be completed progressively between Sutherland and Kirrawee.

Stage 1 will open in sections as each area is completed with bike riders and pedestrians able to use all of Stage 1 by early 2020.

## Upcoming activities

To allow the works to proceed a site compound will be located on Roads and Maritime Services land at **1R Hunter Street, Kirrawee** (vacant land between Johnston Avenue and Forest Road). The compound will use part of this land as shown on the aerial map overleaf.

The site compound will be set up from **Wednesday 27 February 2019** and will be used for stockpiling and storage of materials and equipment, site sheds and amenities.

The compound will be at this location for the duration of Stage 1 of this project. When the works are complete the site will be returned to its current condition.

## Construction equipment

Equipment to be used to set up the compound includes a bobcat, excavator, trucks, work vehicles and various hand and power tools.


Transport for NSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed efficiently.

We will be installing noise blankets and positioning buildings, equipment and lighting to minimise compound impacts on nearby residents.

Project staff will have parking on-site to minimise the impact on local parking.
