Stage 1 Sutherland to Kirrawee

The Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) is a pedestrian and bicycle path between Sutherland and Cronulla to help make walking and bike riding a more convenient, safer and enjoyable transport option.

Stage 1 Sutherland to Kirrawee will connect key destinations such as transport interchanges, schools, residential areas and business precincts.

Construction of Stage 1 is underway, and work will be completed progressively between Sutherland and Kirrawee. Stage 1 will be opened as each area is completed with bike riders and pedestrians able to use all of Stage 1 by early 2020.

Continuing work on Eton Street, Sutherland

Work will continue on Eton Street to complete the construction of the new pedestrian and bicycle path from **Monday 15 July** until **Saturday 17 August**, weather permitting. The work involves landscaping, line marking and kerb concreting to continue building the pathway along Eton Street to join up with President Avenue. Our works hours are from **7am till 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm** on Saturdays.

There will be some impact on parking spaces along Eton Street, alongside Sutherland Public School. These spaces will be re-instated upon completion on this section of work. However, once the pedestrian and bicycle path are complete along Eton Street, parking will no longer be available in this section. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, with traffic control present when work is in progress. Please see information and the map overleaf for more detail about the work.

Night work on Eton Street, Sutherland

Construction of the new shared zone on Eton Street will continue with some works required outside of standard work hours to minimise impacts on local traffic and for the safety of pedestrians and workers.

Eton Street will have partial closures and detours between Boyle Street and President Avenue for **one night shift** from **7pm to 5am**, between **Monday 15 July** and **Wednesday 17 July**. We will have an arborist on site to assess the condition of roots under the road.

Eton Street will also have partial closures and detours to relocate utilities between Boyle Street and McCubbens Lane for **two night shifts** from **7pm to 5am**, between **Monday 22 July** and **Saturday 10 August**. This work is subject to Sydney Water approvals.

Night work activities will include movement of trucks and excavators, and the use of various hand and power tools.

This work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise impacts by completing noisier work as early as possible, switching off equipment when it is not being used, placing equipment as far away from residential properties as possible, and monitoring our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively.

There may be temporary traffic changes during night work to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and detours will be advised through signage and traffic controllers will be in place. Please keep to the speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Please allow additional travel times and we thank you for your patience during these works.
