

New Intercity Fleet Stations and Signalling Modifications

MAY 2019 COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION – LITHGOW STATION

A New Intercity Fleet will replace trains carrying customers to Sydney from the Central Coast, Newcastle, the Blue Mountains and the South Coast.

The new state-of-the-art trains will replace the ageing V-Sets to provide customers with a more comfortable and reliable journey. The trains will feature wider, more spacious seats with arm rests, charging facilities for mobile devices, two by two seating for extra room and comfort, dedicated spaces for luggage, prams, bicycles and wheelchairs, improved accessibility including accessible toilets, tray tables with cup holders, improved customer information through digital information screens and announcements, CCTV and help points, and modern air conditioning.

Project overview

Modifications will be made to existing rail infrastructure at a number of stations along the Blue Mountains Line to support the introduction of the New Intercity Fleet and allow for improved technology on the new trains.

Work at Lithgow Station includes platform extensions, upgrades to platform drainage and installation of additional CCTV cameras and lighting.

Finishing work and removing site compounds	Monday 3 to Friday 14 June between 7am and 6pm on weekdays and between 8am and 1pm on Saturday.

We will let you know in advance if we need to work outside these times.

The site compounds will be used for storage of materials and equipment throughout work at Lithgow Station until mid-June.

To help ensure the safety of workers and the community, the carpark at the corner of Railway Parade and Sandford Avenue, and about 12 car spaces on Railway Parade (next to the bus stop), will be temporarily removed for the site compounds. The length of bus stop on Railway Parade will also be temporarily reduced during the work. We apologise for any inconvenience. A map of the work areas is provided over page.

What you may notice

Equipment to be used includes excavators, concrete truck, vacuum truck, dump truck, generators, cranes and hand tools. Work may be noisy at times, however we will take every possible step to reduce noise such as turning off machinery when not in use.
