Surry Hills to Central Station Feeder Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Transport for NSW is upgrading electrical infrastructure as part of the Power Supply Upgrade Program, which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air-conditioned trains.

A new power supply cable will be installed between the Ausgrid Substation in Ann Street, Surry Hills and the new Chalmers Street Substation at Central Station. Novo Rail is delivering the project on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Upcoming construction activities

We will carry out service investigation works in Surry Hills prior to the installation of the new power supply cable. Between **7pm and 5am from Tuesday 23 July to Friday 26 July** we will carry out these investigations along Albion Street between Elizabeth Street and Commonwealth Street, Surry Hills.

Temporary road closures – Mary and Commonwealth Streets

From **7pm to 5am on Tuesday 23 July to Friday 26 July**, underground service searching works will take place on Albion Street between Elizabeth Street and Commonwealth Street, Surry Hills.

Access to and from Mary Street and Commonwealth Street from Albion Street will unavailable while work is carried out. However, access to Mary Street will be available from Reservoir Street and access to Commonwealth Street will be via Reservoir Street or Ann Street.

The temporary road closures will not occur at the same time, one of these streets will remain open at all times.

Traffic controllers will be in place to provide directions to motorists and pedestrians.

Residential access will be maintained at all times.

Construction equipment

Equipment to be used during the work activities includes excavator, tip trucks, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, lighting towers, generator, work vehicles and various hand and power tools.

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed efficiently.
