

Power Supply Upgrade Program

Surry Hills to Central Station Feeder Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

DECEMBER 2019

Transport for NSW is upgrading electrical infrastructure as part of the Power Supply Upgrade Program, which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air-conditioned trains.

We are installing a new power supply cable between the Ausgrid Substation in Ann Street, Surry Hills and the Chalmers Street Substation at Central Station. Novo Rail is delivering the project on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Project update

Excavation of a new trench along Albion Street, between the Mary Street intersection and the Belmore Street intersection, has been completed. Trenching work in Frog Hollow Reserve has also started. A concrete pit was installed within the Elizabeth Street garden area opposite Albion Street, Surry Hills. We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work. Our work will conclude for this year on Friday 20 December. We will resume work on Monday 6 January 2020.

Upcoming construction activities

This month we will continue trenching and excavation work in the Surry Hills area. To ensure the safety of the community and our workers, minimise traffic impacts and to complete the work as quickly as possible, night work will occur throughout December in targeted areas.

These activities relate to power supply services within the rail corridor only and will not affect power at residential or commercial properties.

Dates and times listed in this notification are indicative and may be subject to change, please check the electronic signboards for up to date information. Traffic delays may be experienced, however every effort will be made to keep any delays to a minimum.

What you may notice

Albion Street, Surry Hills

We will move progressively along Albion Street, as we excavate the trench and install pipes for the new power cable. Once the pipes are installed, the power cable will be fed through the pipes in early 2020.

			There will be no impact to any property sewer services.
			Temporary road impacts Up to 15 parking spaces will be temporarily removed in stages as the work moves along Albion Street.
			Between 7pm and 5am a temporary lane closure will be in place along Albion Street between Elizabeth Street and Riley Street while sewer filming is carried out.
Ongoing until Friday 20 December	Day work	Monday – Friday 7am – 6pm	Excavation of a trench along Albion Street (between Mary Street and Riley Street).
	Night work	Monday – Thursday 7pm – 5am	Temporary road impacts Up to 15 parking spaces will be temporarily removed in stages as the work moves along Albion Street.
			Between 10am and 3pm and 7pm and 5am a temporary lane closure will be in place along Albion Street between Elizabeth Street and Riley Street.
			Temporary day and night road closures will be in place at the intersection of Mary, Bellevue and Belmore Streets on the south side of Albion Street. This work will take around five days per intersection to complete.
			Traffic control, electronic sign boards and detour signs will be in place to provide directions to motorists and pedestrians. Electronic signboards will provide dates of intersection closures.

Elizabeth Street and Eddy Avenue, Surry Hills

Monday 2 December to Friday 20 December, and again from early 2020.	Day work	Monday – Friday 7am - 6pm	Continue working inside the Elizabeth Street garden area between Eddy Avenue and Albion Street. A pedestrian detour will be in place around the work zone. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct pedestrians.

Frog Hollow Reserve, Surry Hills

Date	Type of work	Work Hours	Activities
Wednesday 27 November to Friday 20 December	Day work	Monday – Friday 7am - 6pm	Excavation of a trench in Frog Hollow Reserve. Access to the reserve will be maintained, however the pedestrian ramp will be closed when working in this area of the park. For the safety of the community, the excavation area on the western side of the park will be fenced off from Wednesday 27 November to Saturday 18 January. Tree trimming and removal will take place, subject to approval. Up to four trees may be removed for the new cable route. All care will be taken to preserve these trees and an independent arborist will be on site to monitor the work and assess the trees. Replacement trees will be planted in the park once the work is completed, in consultation with the City of Sydney. Temporary road impacts Periodic traffic lane and footpath closures from Monday 2 December to Friday 20 December on the north side of Albion Street, between Crawford Place and Riley Street, while work is carried out. There may be minor traffic delays. Traffic control and detour signs will be in place.

Construction equipment

Equipment to be used during the work activities includes excavators, tip trucks, jackhammers, generators, road saws, concrete truck, a concrete pump, compactors, vacuum trucks, a video camera, lighting towers, work vehicles and various hand and power tools.

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively.

Other work in the Surry Hills area

A new high voltage cable is being installed in Surry Hills as part of the Sydney Metro City & Southwest project. Sydney Metro investigation work is currently underway in Elizabeth Street, Kippax Street, the top of Albion Street near Frog Hollow Reserve, Bellevue Street and Foveaux Streets and will continue until mid-December 2019.
