

New Intercity Fleet Maintenance Facility

Changed traffic conditions on Enterprise Drive from Wednesday 6 November 2019

The NSW Government is delivering a New Intercity Fleet to replace the trains carrying customers from Sydney to the Central Coast, Newcastle, the Blue Mountains and the South Coast. The detailed design and construction of the new maintenance facility at Kangy Angy, which will service and maintain the New Intercity Fleet, is being delivered by John Holland on behalf of Transport for NSW.

As part of the project, we are building a new roundabout at the intersection of Enterprise Drive and Old Chittaway Road to help improve traffic flow in the area once the new facility starts operating. The roundabout will link to the new bridge being built to access the maintenance facility and provide all-weather access for local residents. The roundabout will include safety features such as dedicated approach and exit lanes, and cycle and pedestrian pathways.

Traffic changes

To allow construction of the roundabout, traffic on Enterprise Drive will be shifted onto the south-eastern side of the road, between Chittaway and Old Chittaway Roads (approximate distance of 280m) from **Wednesday 6 November** (see map overleaf). This traffic arrangement is needed to allow work to be carried out on the existing road and is expected to remain in place for **four to six weeks**, weather permitting.

The re-alignment involves removing existing line markings on the road and replacing with new line markings, and re-positioning existing concrete safety barriers. To minimise disruption to traffic, and help ensure the safety of workers and road users, **this work will be carried out at night between 6pm and 7am on Wednesday 6 November and Thursday 7 November**, weather permitting. Traffic control will be in place during the work. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Pedestrian and cycling changes

Pedestrians and cyclists should use caution and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs during the re-alignment work. .

What you may notice

Equipment to be used includes a road grinder, excavator, a road line marker, compaction equipment, hand tools, lighting towers, tippers, light vehicles and a crane. Work may be noisy at times, however we will take every possible step to reduce noise such as turning off machinery when not in use.
