What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking the removal of two mature trees next to Engadine Station Substation from Saturday 21 September to Sunday 22 September.

The trees require removal to make way for a new retaining wall. All required environmental approvals have been obtained. We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night. We apologise for the inconvenience this may cause.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 10pm Saturday 21 September to 6am Sunday 22 September.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above period. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the worksite.
- Please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near the worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the duration of the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.
