

North Sydney to Hornsby track maintenance

From Saturday 16 November to Monday 18 November

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between North Sydney and Hornsby from Saturday 16 November to Monday 18 November.

Between Killara and Gordon stations, Sydney Metro is undertaking signal and electrical upgrades to increase capacity on the North Shore Line.

Between Artarmon and Chatswood stations, Sydney Metro is also undertaking drainage improvement work, signalling and electrical upgrades and track earthworks to prepare for the future connection of Sydney Metro Northwest and Sydney Metro City & Southwest.

Minor finishing work may also take place on Frank Channon Walk between the Chatswood Oval pass and Gordon Avenue.

Sydney Trains is working on:

- Cutting works at Pymble and Killara
- Drainage works at Pymble
- Overhead upgrade works at Gordon
- Plain track and turnout resurfacing
- Platform resurfacing at Gordon
- Rail and turnout grinding
- Routine civil, signal and electrical maintenance
- Station upgrade works at Warrawee
- Track reconditioning bog hole at Wahroonga
- Turnout renewal at Waverton
- Vegetation maintenance, litter and graffiti removal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 12.45am Saturday 16 November until 2am Monday 18 November.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods. Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
