What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Circular Quay and St James from Friday 29 November to Monday 2 December.

To improve service reliability and reduce the need for ongoing maintenance, we're undertaking track reconstruction.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works will create additional noise at night and over the weekend. We apologise for the inconvenience.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 7am Friday 29 November to 5pm Monday 2 December.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside of the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Work vehicles will access the rail corridor via George Street at Circular Quay Station.
- **To enable the safe access for work vehicles and machines, there will be partial lane closures on George Street, between Essex Street and Globe Street, from 7am Friday 29 November to 5pm Monday 2 December.**
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.


