What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking track maintenance at Caringbah from Tuesday 10 December to Friday 20 December

To improve service reliability and reduce the need for ongoing maintenance, we're upgrading drainage within the rail corridor.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the day and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place on weekdays between 7am and 5pm from Tuesday 10 December to Friday 20 December.**
- **Work will also take place between 6am and 6pm on Saturday 14 December and Sunday 15 December.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using Taren Road, Curtis Street and Gardere Street to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to direct movements into and out of the rail corridor.
