What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Hurstville and Waterfall from Saturday 14 December to Monday 16 December.

To improve service reliability, we're working on:

- ballast cleaning between Mortdale and Como
- drainage works at Waterfall
- embankment and cutting works various locations
- Engadine footbridge repair works
- plain track and turnout resurfacing
- rail and turnout grinding
- routine civil, signal and electrical maintenance
- station upgrade works at Oatley and Como
- litter and graffiti removal
- vegetation maintenance.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place around the clock from 2am Saturday 14 December until 2am Monday 16 December.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
