

## Redfern to Hornsby track maintenance

From Monday 16 September to Friday 20 September

### What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Redfern and Hornsby from Monday 16 September to Friday 20 September.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro are working on Platforms 16-23 and the upper and lower Northern Concourse and excavating for the Metro platforms (underground former Platforms 13 and 14-15).

Between Gordon and Chatswood stations, Sydney Metro is undertaking signal and electrical upgrades to increase capacity on the North Shore Line.

Between Artarmon and Chatswood stations, Sydney Metro is also undertaking, drainage improvement work, signalling and electrical upgrades and track earthworks to prepare for the future connection of Sydney Metro Northwest and Sydney Metro City & Southwest.

At Chatswood Metro Trains Sydney is undertaking general maintenance on the operational Metro North West Line.

Sydney Trains is working on:

- civil track maintenance
- routine signal and electrical maintenance
- station litter removal.

### How this affects you

#### Noise

- These works may create additional noise on weeknights.
- **Work will take place nightly between 10:30pm and 4am from Monday 16 September to Friday 20 September.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

#### Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
