Wolli Creek to Hurstville track maintenance

From Tuesday 8 October to Friday 11 October

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Wolli Creek and Hurstville from Tuesday 8 October to Friday 11 October.

To improve service reliability, we're working on:

- civil track maintenance
- overhead wiring maintenance
- rail and turnout grinding
- routine signal and electrical maintenance
- litter and graffiti removal
- vegetation maintenance.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise on weeknights.
- **Work will take place nightly between 10pm and 4am from Tuesday 8 October to Friday 11 October.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
