Wahroonga Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

June 2019

Wahroonga Station will be upgraded as part of the Transport Access Program, which aims to provide a better experience for customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated public transport infrastructure.

Following initial community consultation in late 2018, planning and design development is underway to prepare for the public display of the Review of Environmental Factors and submission of heritage approval documentation. Subject to further consultation, heritage approval and planning approval, the station upgrade scope would include a new lift to the station platform, upgrades to station facilities and upgraded platform surface along the Railway Avenue accessible paths to the station.

Project update

Preliminary design work is now underway on the Wahroonga Station Upgrade. In order to progress the design, a suite of on-site investigative works are being undertaken by Laing O'Rourke. These site investigation works are currently expected to take no more than three months to complete.

Weekday site investigations between 20 June and 26 July 2019

For two weeks between Thursday 20 June and the 26 July, site investigation activities will occur during normal work hours of Monday to Friday, from 7am to 6pm. This work will include geotechnical investigations, underground services investigation, surveying and station building condition inspections. The investigative work will occur on the station platform, the pedestrian footpath on the corner of Redleaf Avenue and Railway Avenue, and the Redleaf Avenue overbridge.

Equipment will include a truck mounted geotechnical drilling rig, surveying equipment and hand tools. Some of this work may be noisy at times. Noise monitoring will be in place during this time and actions will be taken to minimise noise where possible.

To facilitate the site investigations, **a small temporary site compound may be set up inside the rail corridor at Warwilla Avenue and Woonona Avenue**, as indicated on the plan overleaf. Upon completion of these investigation works, the site compound will be removed the week after 26 July.

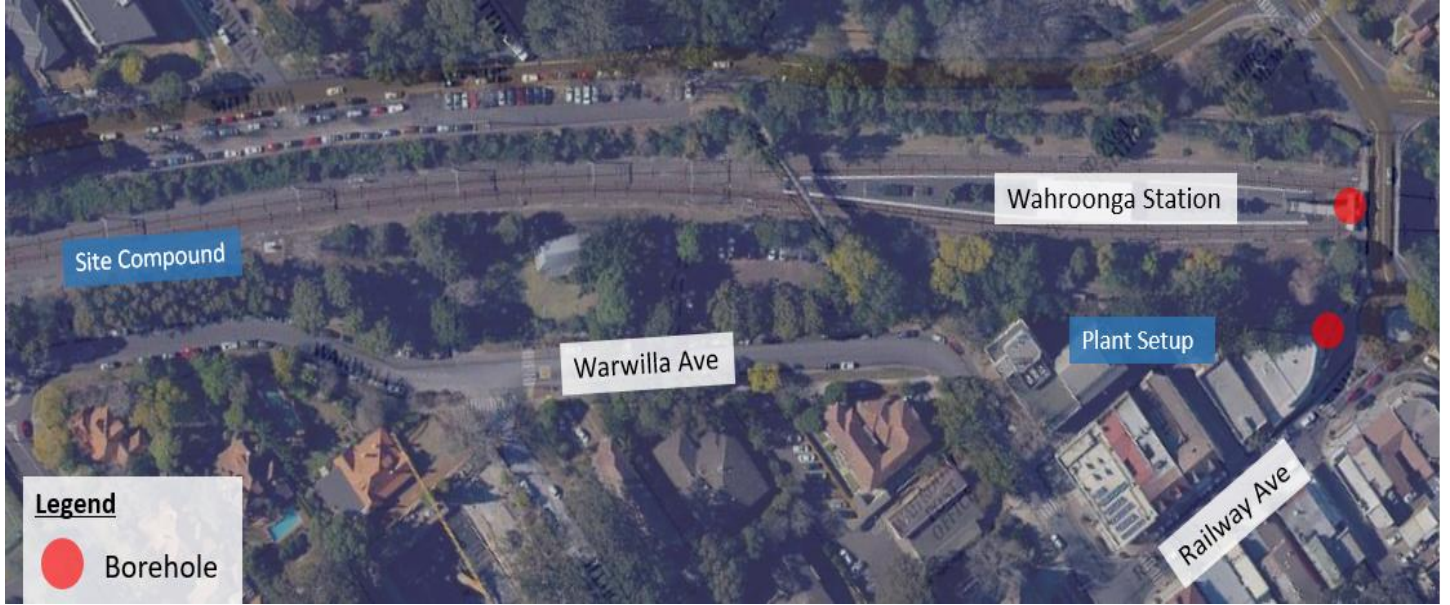
There will be temporary loss of up to 5 parking spaces in the Warwilla Avenue car park and adjacent to a bore hole investigation site. Signage will be in place to advise car park users and pedestrians.

Weekend Works from 22 to 23 June 2019

Site investigations are scheduled to occur during the scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend of 22-23 June 2019, between 7am to 5pm Saturday and 8am to 5pm Sunday.

Work will occur predominantly within the rail corridor, using a vacuum truck in addition to equipment listed above to conduct services investigations. Work has been planned during the scheduled trackwork weekend when no trains will be running, to improve the safety of workers and minimise impact on the community. In preparation for these weekend works, site amenities, plant and equipment will be delivered to the rail corridor off Woonona Avenue.
