Waratah Station Upgrade

Project Update

December 2019



The Waratah Station Upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Project overview

Transport for NSW is upgrading Waratah Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

December work

Construction activities will continue in December and will include:

- installation of cladding and glazing for the three lift shafts
- work to the station toilets and waiting room
- construction of new access stairs and retaining walls on Platt Street.

Equipment to be used includes elevated work platforms, concrete pumps, delivery trucks, vacuum truck, power and hand tools.

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**. Notifications of any work occurring outside of these standard hours will be given prior to work commencing.

Weekend work – Saturday 7 December

From **7am to 9pm on Saturday 7 December 2019** work will be carried out to install the connecting bridge deck, lift shaft awnings and roof for the external station lift on Railway Terrace, weather permitting.

The footpath and corner of York Street and Railway Terrace will be used to create a temporary construction zone where delivery trucks and cranes can operate to lift the structures safely into place.

Equipment to be used includes mobile crane, boom lift, elevated work platforms, delivery trucks, temporary lighting, power and hand tools.

The construction plant will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods for any noisy work.

Traffic changes and detour

To safely operate construction equipment including cranes on Railway Terrace and York Street, some traffic detours and pedestrian access changes will be in place to create a safe work zone.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists with these changes including:

- a temporary road closure (corner of York Street and Railway Terrace – west of Hanbury Street) and detour route (via Dundas Street and Sunnyside Street)
- reduced speed limits.

Toilet and waiting room closure

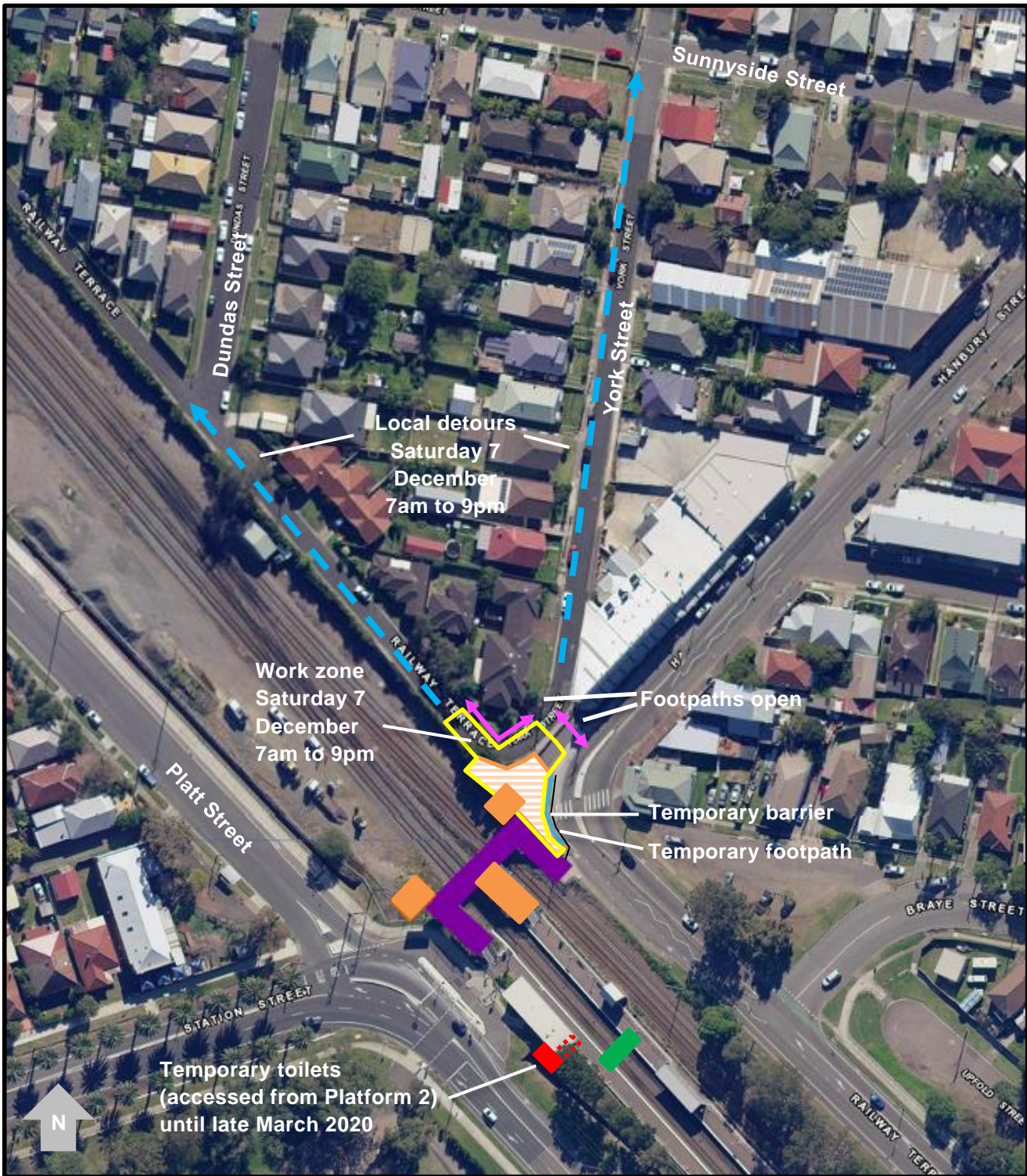
The existing toilets and waiting room on Platform 2 are closed. The waiting room will re-open in early 2020 and the toilets will re-open in late March 2020. Two temporary unisex toilets are located on Platform 2 at the rear of the existing building.
