Waratah Station Upgrade

Project Update

October 2019



The Waratah Station Upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Project overview

Transport for NSW is upgrading Waratah Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

October work

Construction activities will continue in October and include:

- concrete work for the lift on Platform 1 (within hoarding)
- concrete work for the two external lifts, on Platt Street and Railway Terrace
- using a piling drill rig to construct concrete piles and foundations for the external lift shaft on Railway Terrace.

Equipment to be used includes jack hammers, excavators, piling drill rig, concrete pumps, trucks, vacuum truck, surveying equipment, power and hand tools.

Standard construction hours

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**. Notifications of any work occurring outside of these standard hours will be given prior to work commencing.

Weekend work – 26 and 27 October

On **Saturday 26 October** and **Sunday 27 October 2019** weekend work will be carried out at the station, weather permitting. Activities include:

- using a mobile crane to install lift shaft roof, canopies and cladding
- using a mobile crane to connect footbridge via new bridge deck to lifts
- demolition works to existing toilets and waiting room
- installing temporary station toilets
- installing temporary fencing near Platform 2 stairs.

To ensure the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when **no train services will be operating**.

Equipment used includes mobile cranes, forklift, demolition saw and breaker, excavator, dump trucks, concrete trucks, delivery trucks, lighting, power and hand tools.

Construction hours

Work will be carried out continuously from **4am on Saturday 26 October** until **10pm on Sunday 27 October 2019**. The construction plant will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods for any noisy work.

Pedestrian and traffic detours

To safely operate large mobile cranes, some traffic and pedestrian access changes will be in place during the work. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists with these temporary changes.

As there are no train services operating, the **pedestrian bridge will be closed** to pedestrians to create a safe work zone. Detour by walking/cycling around the station precinct using Railway Terrace/Platt Street. Rail replacement buses will be operating from Platt Street.

Toilet and waiting room closure

The existing toilets and waiting room on Platform 2 will be closed from Saturday 27 October. The waiting room will re-open in late December 2019 and the toilets will re-open in late March 2020. Two temporary unisex toilets will be installed on Platform 2 at the rear of the existing building. Please see the map overleaf for the location of the temporary station toilets.

Railway Terrace – temporary changes to footpath and traffic conditions

A partial footpath closure is currently in place on Railway Terrace. Pedestrian access to the footbridge and station will remain and a temporary footpath has been installed to provide a safe thoroughfare around the work zone.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists with this temporary change. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers, adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs. This change is temporary and the footpath will return to normal configuration mid-2020.
