Transport for NSW's 16 Regional Cities Services Improvement Program aims to identify gaps and opportunities around how bus services operate, so we can deliver improvements to better meet community needs.

Improvements could include changes to existing journeys, new routes or services, extended operating hours across the day or week, and better connections to key destinations such as hospitals, TAFEs and universities.

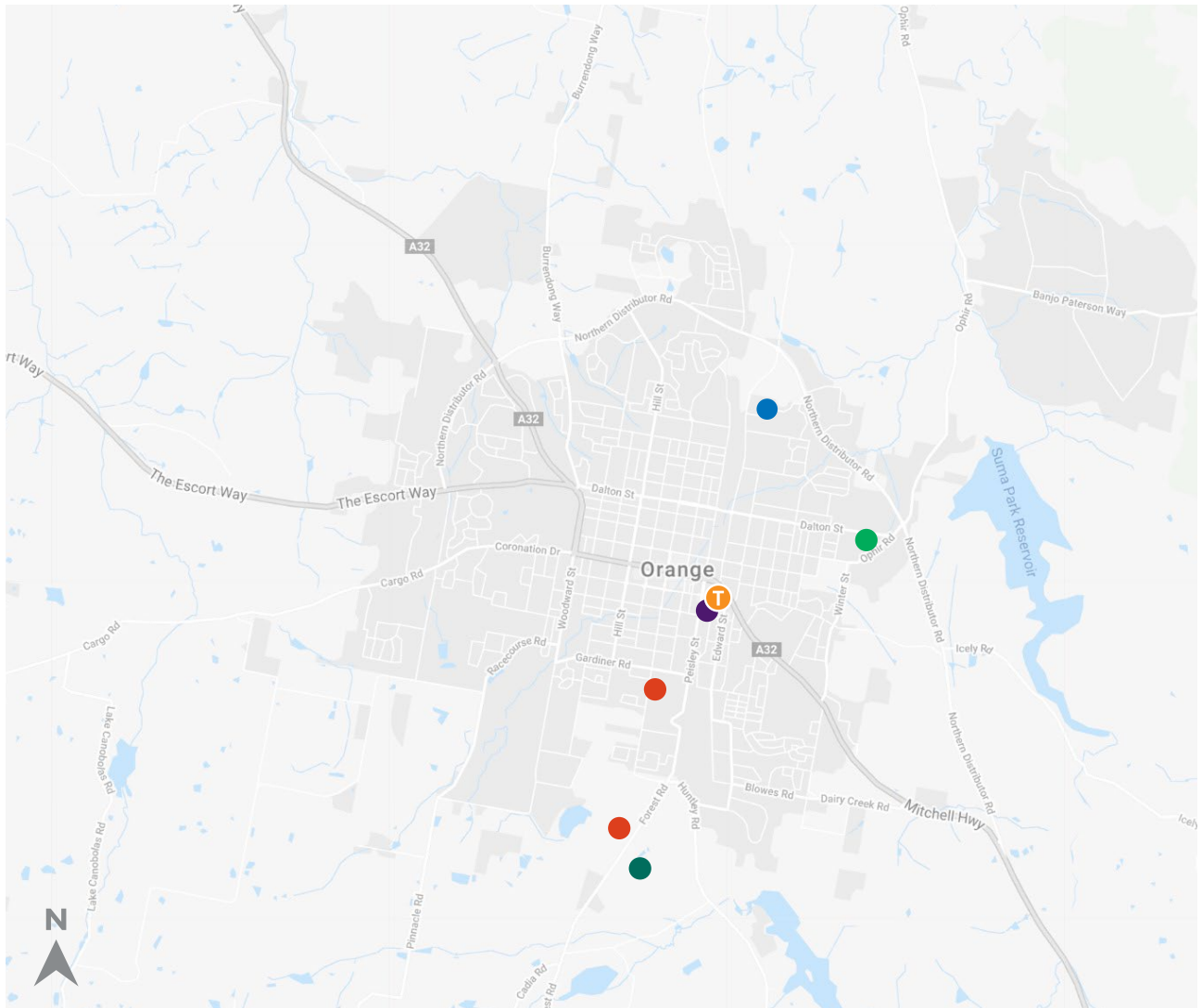
