## Bexley North Station Upgrade

Project Update

May/June 2020

## Project overview

Transport for NSW is upgrading Bexley North Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

The project includes a new lift, upgrade to the Commuter Car Park and footpaths, upgrades to the station building and facilities, new unisex ambulant and a family accessible toilets, new wayfinding signage and upgrades to station security and communication systems.

Work is expected to take around 18 months to complete.

## Upcoming work and site establishment

Site establishment work will begin on **Monday 25 May 2020** and will continue throughout the months of May and June. Activities include:

- installing temporary fencing around the platform canopy at the base of the stairs
- surveying and investigation work
- relocating services from the existing platform canopy.

Equipment which will be used during this work includes: surveying equipment, generators and hand tools.

## Construction hours

To support the industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has introduced new rules allowing construction sites to operate on weekends and public holidays.

**Standard construction hours are from 7am to 6pm every day, including public holidays.** These changes have been made to facilitate physical distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.

We understand extending construction hours to include weekends and public holidays may cause disruption, but all efforts will be made to minimise impacts where possible and ensure strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management are adhered to.

## Weekend work – 30 and 31 May 2020

For improved safety of our workers and customers, work is being planned during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period, when **no trains will be running. The station will be closed** to customers and there will be some construction vehicles working in the car park completing investigations for the upgrades. The pedestrian footbridge will remain open during this period.

Weekend work will be carried out continuously from **2am on Saturday 30 May until 10pm on Sunday 31 May 2020**. Activities include:


- relocating services fixed to the existing eastern platform canopy
- removing the platform canopy and its footings
- services investigation work including surveying.

This work will involve a truck-mounted crane, elevated work platforms, vacuum truck, excavators and hand tools.

Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise including turning off vehicles when not in use, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and stopping work for respite periods.
