



In Brookvale, the signalised pedestrian crossing on Pittwater Road (near William Street) will close in early July. Gates will close off access to pedestrians and the pedestrian crossing signals will be decommissioned. The crossing signals will only be used in future should the pedestrian lifts be out of service.

Customers will need to cross Pittwater Road using the pedestrian bridge via stairs and lifts near the bus stops on each side of Pittwater Road. The closure of the pedestrian crossing will improve traffic flow and safety for pedestrians.

A new dedicated left-hand turn into Cross Street from Pittwater Road opened to traffic in May. The new lane improves the flow of northbound traffic along Pittwater Road. Some final work will continue in July to complete the improvements.

Work during July

Signalised pedestrian crossing

The closure of the pedestrian crossing on Pittwater Road (near William Street) in early July will occur during day time work hours. Signage will be in place in advance of the closure to inform the community.

Cross Street

Construction activities for the left-turn lane into Cross Street will involve pouring and laying the new concrete footpath and pram ramps, minor repairs and traffic control signal works.

Work will occur at the **Cross Street** site located on the map overleaf during the following hours:

- **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**
- **8am to 1pm Saturday**
- **two nights a week from 6pm to 5am** on the dates shown over the page.

Some of the work may be noisy, measures will be implemented to reduce the impact of work, including turning off vehicles when not in use, completing noisy work early in the evening where possible, using barriers to reduce the noise and directing noise and lights away from residents.

The pedestrian crossing at Cross Street will remain temporarily closed to allow for the completion of the footpath and ramp. We apologise for any inconvenience. Please follow our pedestrian detour signs for alternate route options.

Night work at Cross Street

Night work is required outside of standard hours to improve safety for workers, pedestrians and motorists and to minimise impacts to traffic. If a night shift is cancelled due to rain, we will aim to move it to another night that same week.
