

Brookvale construction program Extension of night works program at Cross St January 2020

Dedicated left turn lane into Cross Street

Transport for NSW is managing the construction and installation of a dedicated left hand turn from Pittwater Road northbound into Cross Street, Brookvale. This new left hand turn lane will improve the flow of northbound traffic along Pittwater Road.

Remaining work program

There have been some delays in the construction program due to issues relating to utility connections and cutovers, which rely on the availability of service utility contractors who are required to complete these connections for operation. The remaining work to prepare for this involves cutting into the relocated watermain, removing redundant utilities and pavement construction.

We recently consulted property owners who may be highly impacted by our night work about extending the five nights per week construction program until March 2020. The two week feedback window has closed and there have been no objections to the extension of the night works program. We therefore will continue to work up to five nights a week with two nights respite throughout early 2020, weather permitting. Day works will also continue during this time.

While the date to complete this night work has been pushed back, we are confident there will be minimal impact on residents.

January works

Our January construction work involves:

- adjustments to utilities along Pittwater Road and Cross Street
- removal of redundant utilities
- civil and pavement works

We will again close the footpath along Pittwater Road around to Cross Street in January, with pedestrian detours in place until completion of the project. Please follow instructions from traffic controllers and site signage to safely move around these works.

Hours of work

Night work is undertaken outside of construction hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to traffic. Works are dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Work will occur at the Cross Street site located on the map during the following hours:

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday
- 8am to 1pm Saturday
- up to five nights a week (generally Monday to Friday) from 6pm to 5am

Minimising community impact

Some of the work will be noisy and we try to reduce the noise when we can. Some ways we do this include:

- talking to residents before the work starts, to let them know what to expect
- using barriers and sound blankets to reduce the noise
- the use of squawkers rather than beepers on vehicles
- only using noisy machinery when we absolutely have to
- doing noisy work early in the evening when possible
- directing the noise and lights away from residents when we can

Traffic, parking, bus stop and pedestrian changes

There may be some temporary traffic, parking, bus stop and pedestrian changes to ensure the work zone is safe. There may also be lane closures and pedestrian detours in place during construction. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.


