Transport for NSW has installed a new Digital Train Radio System (DTRS). The DTRS is improving communications between train drivers, controllers and guards across the electrified network. The previous analogue MetroNet Train Radio System is now being removed across the rail network.

Upcoming activities

Due to weather conditions the work planned for Monday 20 January has been rescheduled.

Between 9pm Monday 17 February and 3am Tuesday 18 February or 9pm Tuesday 25 February and 3am Wednesday 26 February, we will be removing a redundant pole within the rail corridor from North Parade, adjacent to Campsie Station.

Traffic changes

There will be a single lane closure on North Parade between Dispensary Lane and London Street, Campsie. Up to six parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable to allow the work to be carried out safely. Traffic control will be in place to direct pedestrians and motorists around the work site.

Construction equipment

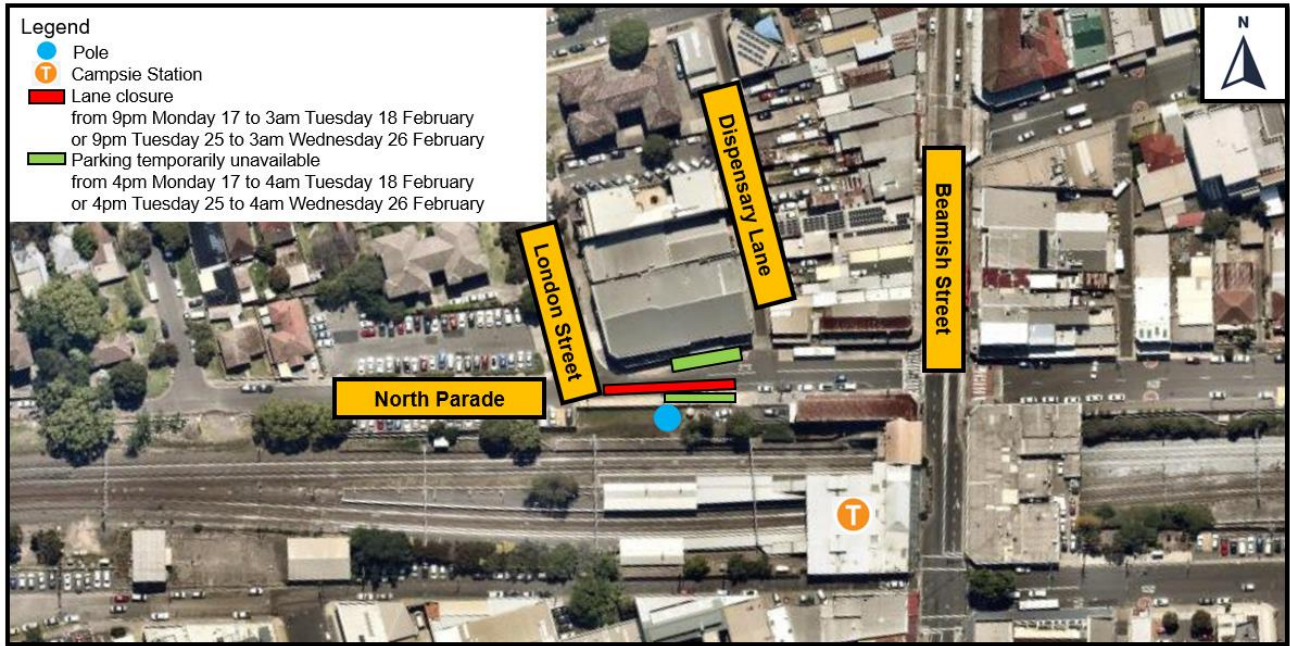
Equipment to be used includes a cherry picker, work vehicles and various hand and power tools.
