## Erskineville Station Upgrade

**COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION**

**October 2020**

Planning is underway for an accessibility upgrade at Erskineville Station as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program. This will provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

As part of the planning process, preliminary investigations help identify what upgrades will be required to make Erskineville Station fully accessible. This involves geotechnical work and surveying at the station.

These works will occur from **Saturday 10 October to Tuesday 20 October** intermittently and predominantly during standard working hours. **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.**

These works will include:

- drilling investigative boreholes
- design surveys
- topographical surveys,
- identifying services.

Equipment used will include:

- small drilling rig
- powered hand tools and surveying equipment
- lighting towers and generators
- vacuum truck

Some of this work will be noisy at times. We make every effort to minimise the impact on nearby residents and businesses.

### Upcoming weekend works

**From 6am Saturday 10 October to 6pm Sunday 11 October**, weekend and night works will occur at Erskineville Station during a scheduled Sydney Trains shutdown to undertake borehole and survey investigations on Platform 2. This work will be undertaken while trains are not running in this area to ensure the safety of workers and customers.

A temporary site shed, two portaloos and a small generator will also be established within the station site for the weekend works.

We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience during these works.

## Train services, replacement buses and pedestrian access
