Faulconbridge Station Upgrade

Project update

January 2021

Upcoming work in January

The upgrade to Faulconbridge Station is progressing well. The station waiting room and toilets reopened in December and work progressed on the lifts and ramp.

Construction activities in January will include:

- upgrading the ramp between the footbridge and Railway Avenue commuter car park
- work on the two lifts
- modifying and removing lift scaffold structures
- installing new power supply service from Sir Henry Parade to the station
- landscaping.

Equipment to be used during this work will include excavators, compactors, mobile cranes, elevated work platforms, delivery and concrete trucks, and powered hand tools.

Night work – Monday 18 January to Friday 22 January 2021

Night work will be carried out between **8pm and 5am Monday 18 January to Friday 22 January 2021**, weather permitting. This work includes the removal of lift scaffolds and the delivery of lift materials at the two lift locations.

To maintain the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork, when no train services will be operating. Equipment to be used during this work will include delivery trucks and powered hand tools.

For the safety of workers and motorists, there will be a temporary lane closure on the Great Western Highway (westbound) during this work. Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with this change.

Temporary traffic changes – Sir Henry Parade

During January 2021 we will be restoring the road surface as part of the power supply upgrade to the station. This work will be undertaken over approximately two days, weather permitting.

To maintain the safety of workers and the community, there will be a temporary single lane closure on Sir Henry Parade under the direction of traffic controllers. Signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with the temporary changes.

Temporary traffic changes – Great Western Highway

During January 2021 there will be intermittent single lane road closures on Great Western Highway (westbound) near Faulconbridge Station. The intermittent closures will take place between **Monday and Friday** from **10am to 2pm** to accommodate large construction vehicles. Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with the traffic changes.

Temporary access changes – between footbridge and commuter car park

Work continues in January to upgrade the ramp between the footbridge and Railway Avenue commuter car park. This includes constructing a retaining wall, earthwork and construction of the new concrete footpath/ramp. Pedestrian and vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Holiday closure

During the holiday period our site office will be closed to provide the community and our workers a break from construction work.

We wish you a safe and happy holiday season and look forward to comleting the Faulconbridge Station Upgrade in 2021.

Standard construction hours

Our construction hours are now 7am to 6pm every day, including public holidays.

We understand extending construction hours to weekends and public holidays may cause disruption for the community and all efforts will be made to minimise impacts where possible.
