

# Transport Access Program

## Hawkesbury River Station Upgrade

**Project update**

**September 2020**

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Hawkesbury River Station. The upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

Early work commenced in November 2019 with construction expected to be complete in early 2021.

### Upcoming work

Work will continue in September and include:

- construction and fit out of the new accessible toilet
- demolition of the existing female toilet
- installation of the canopy and cladding to the lift on Dangar Road
- installation of a new transformer and power supply
- demolition of the existing footpath to make way for a new footpath between Dangar Road lift and the Brooklyn wharf.

Equipment to be used includes small excavators, tipper truck, heavy vehicles, hand tools, generators, cranes, elevated work platforms, and concrete saws.

**Work will be carried out during standard construction hours, which are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday.**

We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

### Toilet amenities

The new unisex family accessible toilet was completed in August and is open for use. The female toilet, which was converted to unisex during these works, will be closed and demolished in September.

## Traffic, pedestrian and parking changes

To assist pedestrians and motorists, traffic control will be in place from time to time on Dangar Road during construction work and deliveries.

A temporary footpath has been established on Dangar Road to divert pedestrians away from construction work. This diversion will remain in place until October 2020. Signs and traffic control are in place to assist pedestrians.
