## Hawkesbury River Station Upgrade

### Project update

January 2021

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Hawkesbury River Station. The upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

### Upcoming work

Work will continue in January 2021 and include:

- construction of new kerb and gutter and footpath to the bus stop on Dangar Road
- adjustments to the existing communication pits in Dangar Road
- completion of the concrete pram ramps and paving
- coating the Dangar Road pedestrian crossing in coloured asphalt
- line marking on Dangar Road
- minor work including defect rectification
- demobilisation of site facilities.

Equipment to be used includes cranes, small excavators, concrete saws, concrete delivery trucks and delivery vehicles.

**Work will mostly be carried out during standard construction hours, which is 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 6pm Saturday.**

### Night work – Thursday 28 January

From 6pm until 9pm on Thursday 28 January 2021, line marking will take place on Dangar Road, weather permitting. There will be some noise associated with this work. There will be intermittent lane closures while this work is carried out. Traffic control will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists.

## Traffic, pedestrian and parking changes

A new accessible car space in Dangar Road car park is now available for use for holders of a Mobility Parking Scheme permit.

From **11 January to 22 January 2021**, the bus stop on Dangar Road will be temporarily relocated to Brooklyn Road in front of The Angler's Rest. Four car spaces will be temporarily unavailable in this location to allow for the temporary relocation of the bus stop. Signs are in place to assist bus passengers.

Signs and traffic control will be in place to assist road users and pedestrians during construction of kerb and gutter and footpath work on Dangar Road.
