## Lapstone Station Upgrade

**Project update**

**November 2020**

### Power Supply Upgrade

Construction work to upgrade the local power supply at Lapstone Station is required as part of the station upgrade. This is to ensure the station has the correct power supply to operate the new lift.

From **Monday 16 November 2020**, work will be carried out to install underground power supply directly beneath footpaths and driveways extending from the station along Explorers Road to Hume Road, **subject to approval**. Work will be undertaken in sections to eliminate the need for road closures. The work is expected to **take up to four months to complete**, weather permitting.

Construction activities will include:

- drilling test pits along footpaths and the road to investigate existing underground services
- installing temporary fencing, signage, barriers and other controls around work areas
- removal of up to four trees and vegetation near the commuter car park (subject to approval)
- excavation and trenching to install new underground power supply
- temporary restoration of trenched driveways (permanent restoration to occur in early 2021)
- connection to underground power supply network and the station.

Equipment to be used during this work includes mobile crane, excavators, delivery and concrete trucks, power and hand held tools. Some of this work may be noisy at times and actions will be taken to minimise noise where possible, by providing regular respite periods. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this important work.

To allow this essential work to take place, there will be a **planned power interruption managed by Endeavour Energy**. Residents and businesses affected by the power interruption will receive more information from Endeavour Energy about timing and ways to get assistance.

### Temporary traffic, driveway access and parking changes

Throughout our work to upgrade the power supply there will be temporary traffic and driveway access changes. Residential access to properties will be maintained at all times. Temporary access changes on Explorers Road and Hume Road during construction hours **7am to 6pm** includes:

- temporary footpath closures (in sections)
- temporary closure of individual driveways while excavation and footpath restoration work occurs (in sections)

- single lane road closures and/or temporary on-street parking removal (in sections).

We will provide advance notice to residents at individual properties before driveways are temporarily closed. Temporary closure of individual driveways is expected to take up to 10 hours. We recommend residents move their vehicles to the street for use during this time.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists.
