



# Transport Access Program

## Lapstone Station Upgrade

**Project update**

**September to November 2020**

The upgrade at Lapstone Station is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.



## Upcoming work

Construction on the Lapstone Station Upgrade is progressing well with site establishment activities undertaken in June and August.

Construction activities will continue in September and include:

- electrical and water service installation work at the station platform and surrounding precinct
- concrete and steel work for the new lift
- concrete, excavation and electrical and water services relocation work for the new station entrance
- demolishing and reconfiguring sections of the platform and station building.

Equipment to be used during this work includes mobile crane, small drilling rig, excavators, surveying equipment, delivery and concrete trucks, power and hand held tools.

## Temporary commuter car park changes from 11 September

From **8:30am Friday 11 September 2020 until April 2021**, approximately 20 spaces will be temporarily unavailable to allow for station upgrade work within the commuter car park to be completed safely. The accessible parking space will be relocated closer to the temporary station entrance.

**The commuter car park entry driveway will be closed to vehicles from 8:30am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday** to allow for construction work to raise the ground levels between the footbridge and commuter car park, and upgrading the footpath and station building.

Access to residential parking spaces will be maintained at all times.

Untimed parking is available for commuters on Explorers Road, Lapstone.

Barriers and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with the temporary changes. Traffic control will be in place to assist construction and large vehicles to enter and exit the commuter car park.

## Weekend work – 11, 12 and 13 September 2020

Work activities will **take place continuously from 6pm Friday 11 September until 6am Monday 14 September 2020** during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend, when no trains will be running.

**The pedestrian footbridge across the station including connection to the Leonay fire trail will be closed from 6am Saturday 12 September until 6pm Sunday 13 September.**

Work will include platform resurfacing, demolition work, concrete work and electrical and water service relocation work around the station precinct. Work will also include relocating station entry points and setting up a temporary construction work area within the commuter car park.

Equipment to be used includes mobile cranes, excavators, surveying equipment, delivery/concrete trucks, concrete pumps, construction trucks, power and hand held tools.

Measures will be implemented to reduce noise associated with this work, including using non-tonal reversing alarms, turning machinery off when not in use and monitoring noise levels.

## Temporary changes to the station entry from 14 September

From **Monday 14 September 2020 until April 2021**, the entry to Platforms 1 and 2 will change. Customers will be directed to a temporary station entry towards the Glenbrook end of Platform 1.

This change will be in place to allow for construction work to raise the ground level between the footbridge and commuter car park, and upgrade the footpath and station building to ensure compliance with disability standards.

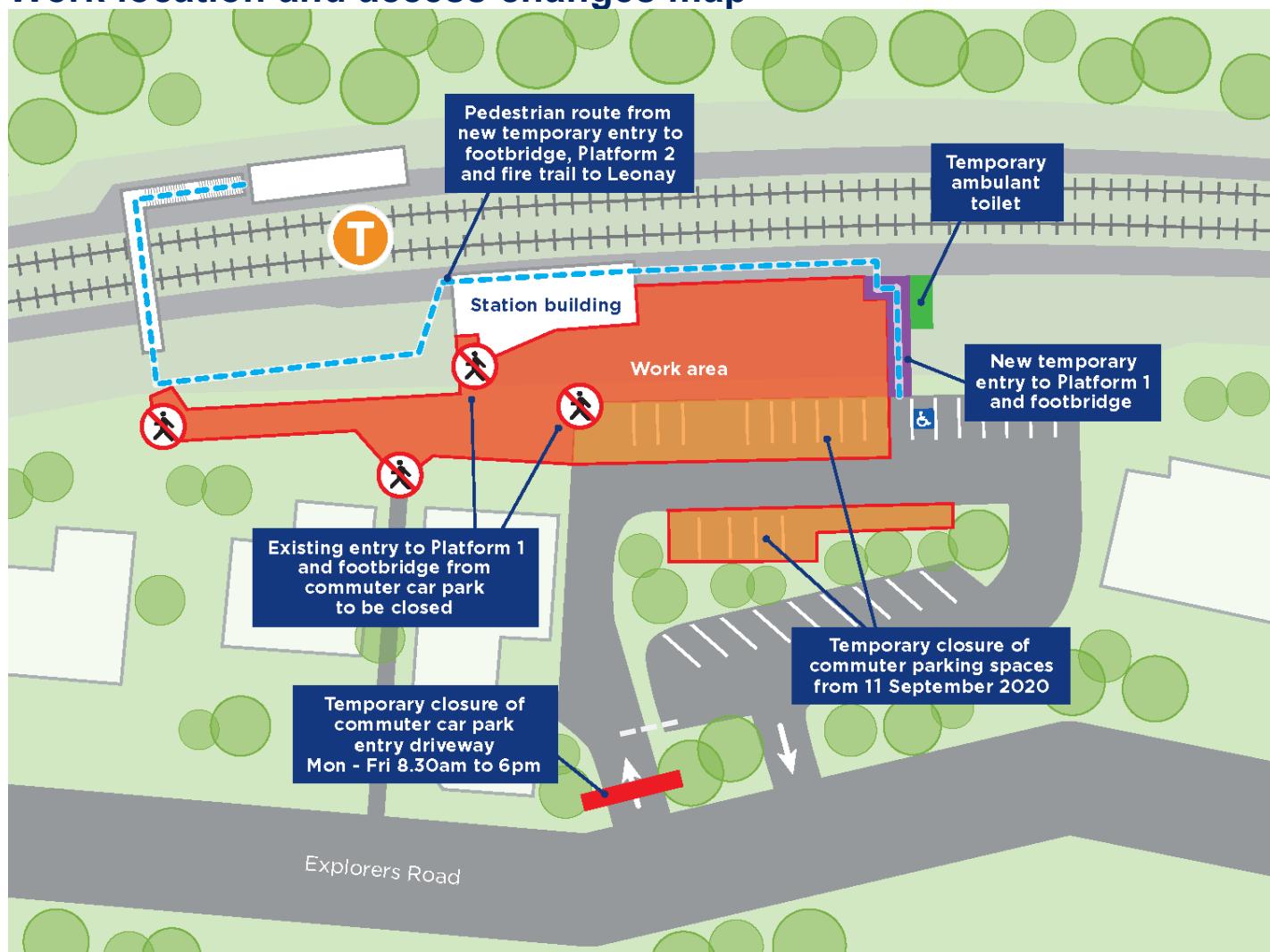
Signage will be in place to assist customers with these changes.

## Temporary traffic, access and parking changes

Throughout our work, there may be ongoing temporary traffic and access changes surrounding Lapstone Station on Explorers Road or Leonay fire trail. Subject to approval, access changes may include **temporary footpath closures, single lane road closures and/or temporary parking removal** to accommodate large vehicles undertaking construction work and to enable removal of construction materials from the work areas.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with all temporary changes.

## Station toilets closure

The toilets on Platform 1 remain closed for refurbishment. New toilets are expected to reopen in April 2021. A temporary unisex toilet is located at the Glenbrook end of the station building on Platform 1.

## Construction hours

**Standard construction hours are now 7am to 6pm every day, including public holidays.**

We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

We understand extending construction hours to weekends and public holidays may cause disruption for the community but all efforts will be made to minimise impacts where possible and ensure strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management are adhered to.

Thank you for your patience as work continues on important transport infrastructure across NSW.
