What's happening in Mosman?

In February, utility relocation and civil works continued in Mosman for the extension of the bus indent on Spit Road at Parriwi Road and the construction of a new bus indent on Military Road at Prince Street.

We expect to finalise the extended/new bus indents in March and reopen the bus stops in April 2020.

The following activities will continue along Spit Road and Military Road throughout March.

Bus indent extension at Parriwi Road

Day works will be undertaken from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday** and will include:

civil works to construct extended bus indent including new footpath, kerb and landscaping

Bus indent at Prince Street

Day works will be undertaken from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday** and will include:

civil works to construct new bus indent including new footpath, kerb and landscaping

There may be a requirement to work nights to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians, motorists and to minimise impacts to traffic. These will be communicated to impacted stakeholders seven days prior to any night work commencing.

Traffic, parking and pedestrian changes

During work periods, there may be temporary changes to parking and bus stops. There may also be temporary lane closures and pedestrian detours required. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users and pedestrians.

Minimising community impact

Some of the work will be noisy and we try to reduce the noise when we can. Some ways we do this include:

- talking to residents before the work starts, to let them know what to expect
- using barriers and sound blankets to reduce the noise
- the use of squawkers rather than beepers on vehicles
- only using noisy machinery when necessary
- doing noisy work early in the evening when possible
- directing the noise and lights away from residents where possible.
