Bus stops to open in May

This month we are nearing completion of the extended bus bay on Spit Road at Parriwi Road and the new bus bay on Military Road at Prince Street, Mosman.

The new and extended bus bays will improve the reliability of bus services by better accommodating bendy buses and multiple single buses. This will improve traffic flow and journey times for buses and motorists, particularly during peak periods.

Both of these bus stops are expected to open to customers in May.

We would like to thank the local Mosman community for your patience and cooperation during construction.

Bus bay extension on Spit Road at Parriwi Road

Work during May will include connecting a new watermain and landscaping, pavement, footpath and kerb activities. These activities will occur between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

The bus stop is expected to open to customers in May. A small work zone will remain in place while the final work is carried out to connect the underground watermain, however the bus stop will be operational. We will provide further communications to confirm the opening date soon.

Bus bay on Military Road at Prince Street

Work during May will include pavement, asphaltting, footpath, landscaping and kerb activities. These activities will occur between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

This bus stop is expected to open to customers in May. The bus stop 70m south at Belmont Road will be moved to service the new bus bay at Prince Street. We will provide further communications to confirm the opening date soon.

Please note that the delivery of new bus shelters has been delayed due to Covid-19. We are investigating options to install temporary bus shelters at both sites in the interim.

Night work

For improved safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to traffic, some **night work will be required at both sites this month, between 6pm and 5am on:**

- **Monday 11 and Tuesday 12 May**
- **Wednesday 20 and Thursday 21 May**
- **Friday 29 and Saturday 30 May**

If a night shift is cancelled due to rain, we will aim to move it to another night in that same week.

Minimising community impact

- using barriers, sound blankets and squawkers rather than beepers on vehicles to reduce noise
- only using noisy machinery when necessary
- doing noisy work early in the evening when possible
- directing the noise and lights away from residents where possible.
